

Upgrading the Pacific Highway Tintenbar to Ewingsdale



The Roads and Traffic Authority (RTA) is identifying an upgrade of the Pacific Highway for approximately 20 kilometres of dual carriageway between Tintenbar and Ewingsdale. Planning for the project is funded by the NSW State Government.

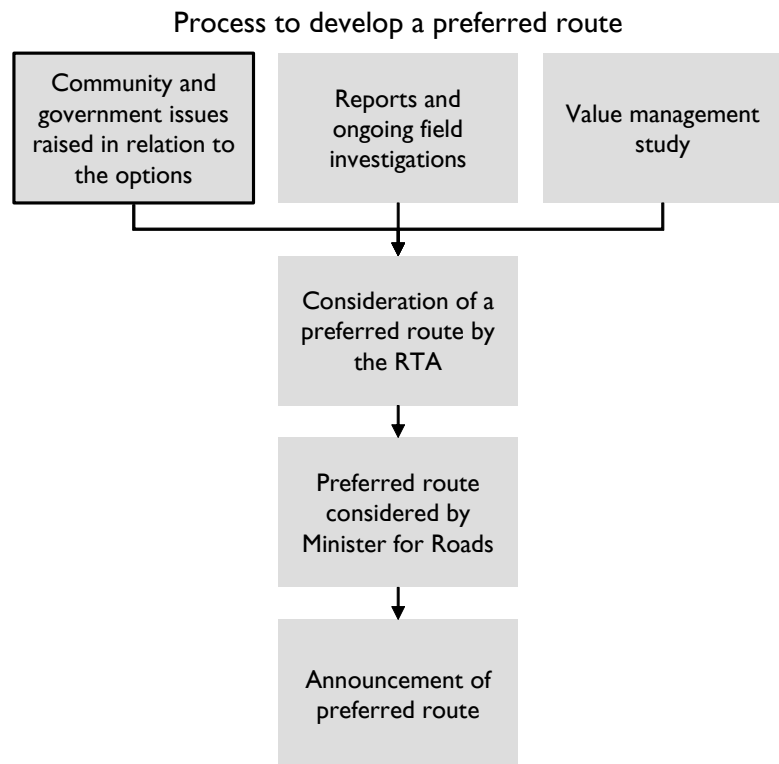
Route options submissions

All community feedback sent to the project team during the route options display has been registered and reviewed. The information contained in public submissions will help the project team progress towards identifying a preferred highway route. Following refinement of a preferred route, the concept design and environmental assessment phases would commence.

No preferred option has been selected at this stage.

Issues raised by the community and government form one of several inputs to the consideration of a preferred route, as shown in this flow chart.

Community involvement is an important part of this project and will continue in the next phases. The Community Liaison Group, updates in the local media, newsletters, meetings with individuals and groups, and the project website will continue to keep the community informed and assist community input.
